
# Alabama PTI's Purpose


- o To increase the capacity of parents of infants, toddlers, and children and youth with disabilities with training and information to enable them to effectively participate in improving results for their children with disabilities.

- O To increase the capacity of service professionals to effectively serve and support families and youth with disabilities.









